
## Bioblitz at Memorial Park *Saturday Sept. 27 - 9:00am*



Sequoia Audubon is joining San Mateo County Parks, along with Save the Redwoods League, CAL Academy, iNaturalist, Nerds for Nature and the San Francisco Mycological Society to bring you the Memorial Park Bioblitz in the redwoods! Join us Saturday, September 27th at 9 AM at the Huckleberry Flat Group Picnic Area to begin Bioblitzing! From there, several teams will split up for two to three hours to explore sections of the park. Together, we'll look for birds, snails, salamanders, frogs, butterflies, spiders, flowers and everything else we can find! Teams will document their findings using smartphones or cameras, then upload and discuss their findings at the Wrap-up session at the Pescadero Country store over pizza from noon to 1 PM. Don't have a camera or smartphone? Don't worry! ### Crystal Springs CBC, *Sunday, Dec. 14, 2014*

The Crystal Springs CBC count circle is centered on the Peninsula and includes the Burlingame shoreline to Redwood Shores on the Bayside and southern Pacifica through Half Moon Bay on the Coastside with the Watershed, Skyline Blvd., and the suburbs in between. Finish the day at the compilation dinner at Round Table pizza in San Mateo Participation in the count is free.

### Año Nuevo CBC, *Saturday, Jan. 3, 2015*

This Count circle includes the area from Pescadero south to Año Nuevo and up as far as Big Basin and Sam McDonald State Park. This year our compilation dinner will again be held at a ranch on the coast with guests invited. Participation in the count is free.
